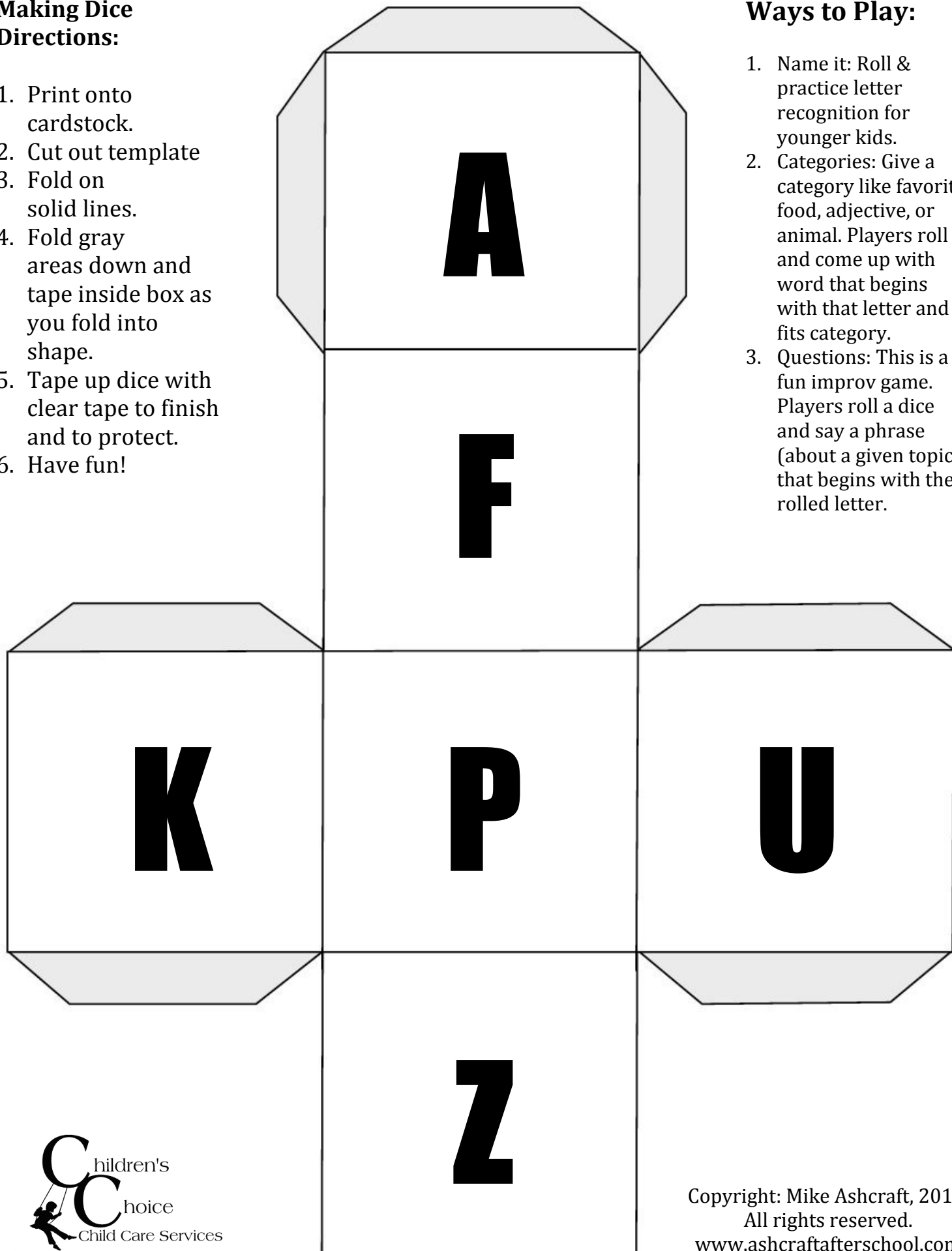


Making Dice

Directions:

1. Print onto cardstock.
2. Cut out template
3. Fold on solid lines.
4. Fold gray areas down and tape inside box as you fold into shape.
5. Tape up dice with clear tape to finish and to protect.
6. Have fun!



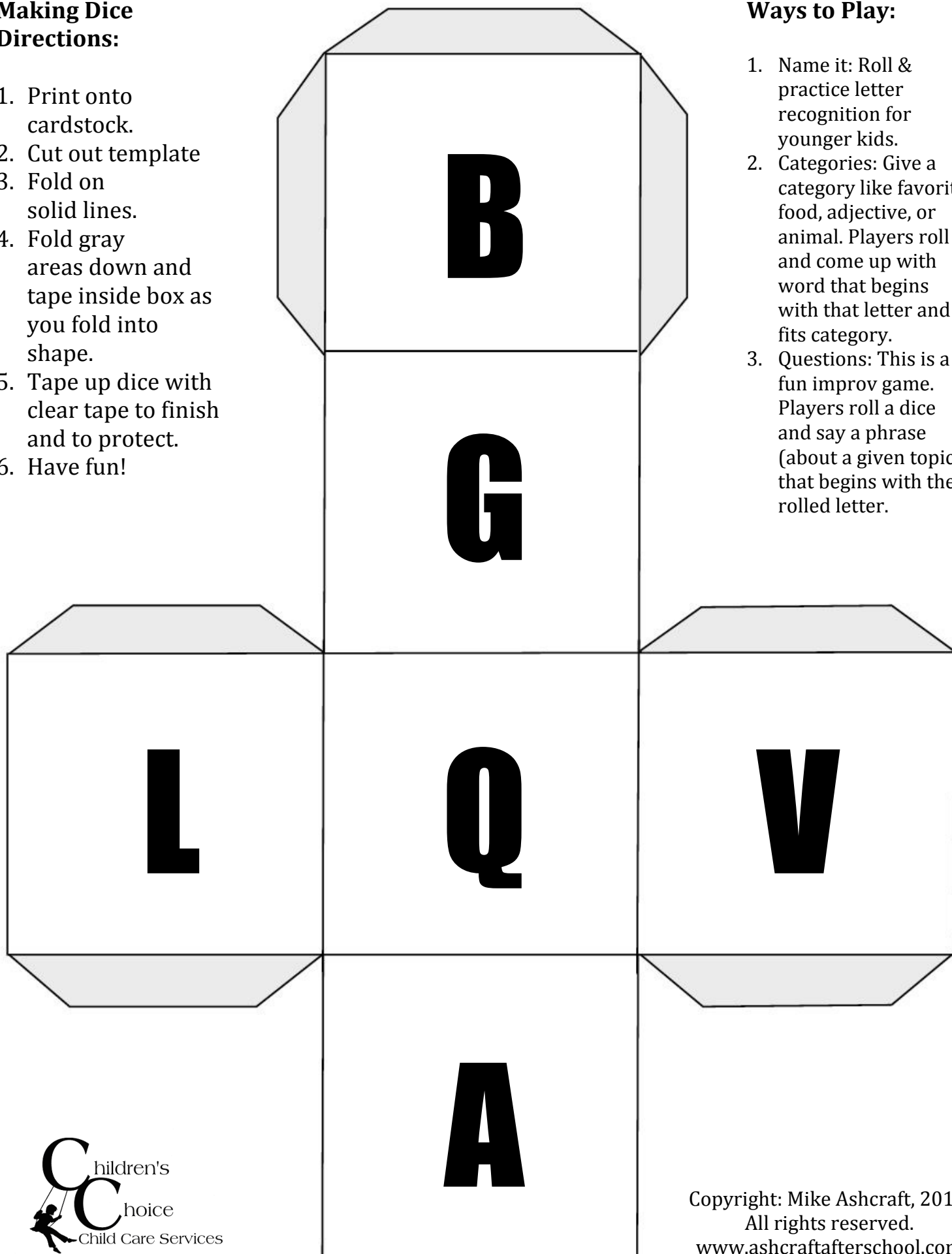
Ways to Play:

1. Name it: Roll & practice letter recognition for younger kids.
2. Categories: Give a category like favorite food, adjective, or animal. Players roll and come up with word that begins with that letter and fits category.
3. Questions: This is a fun improv game. Players roll a dice and say a phrase (about a given topic?) that begins with the rolled letter.

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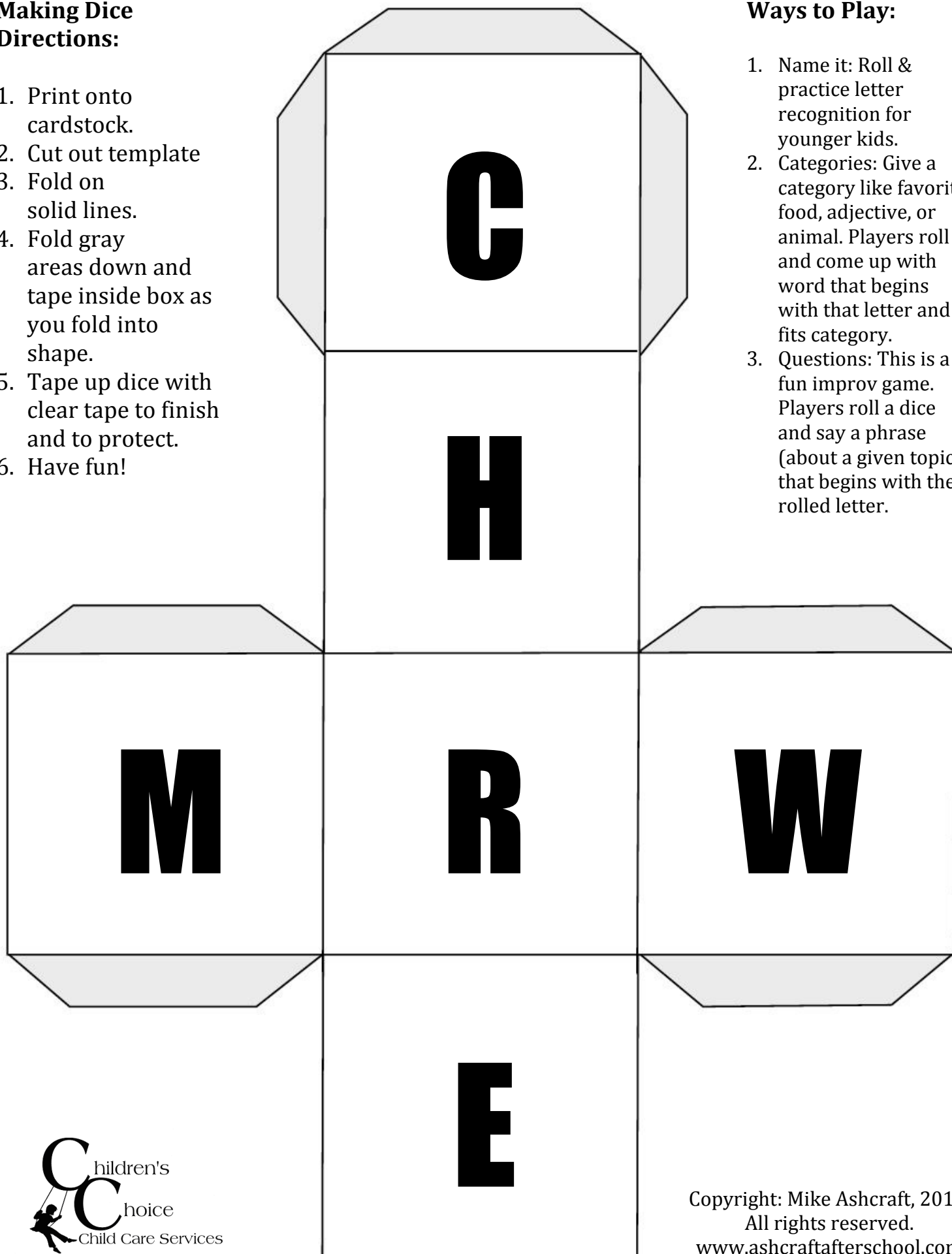
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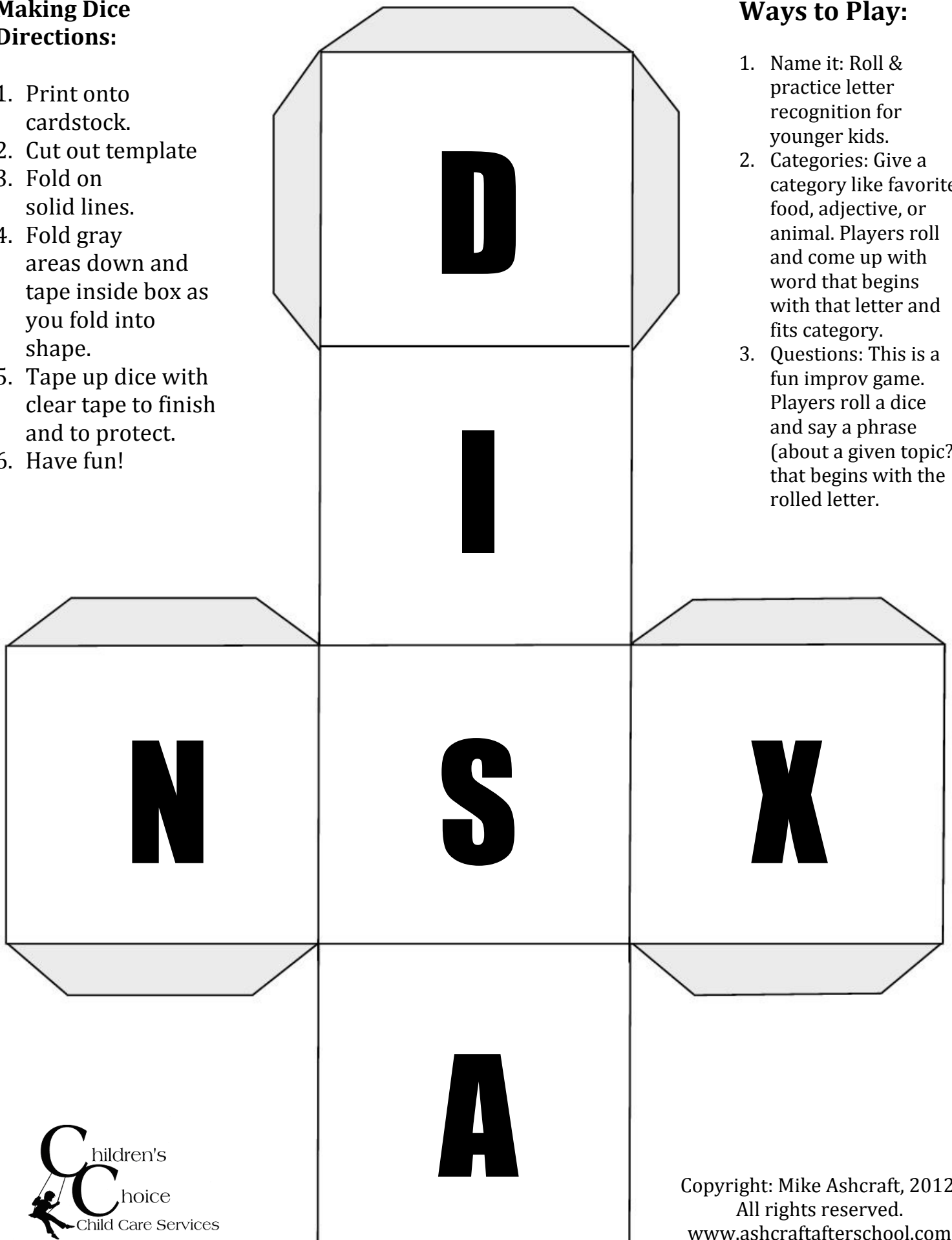
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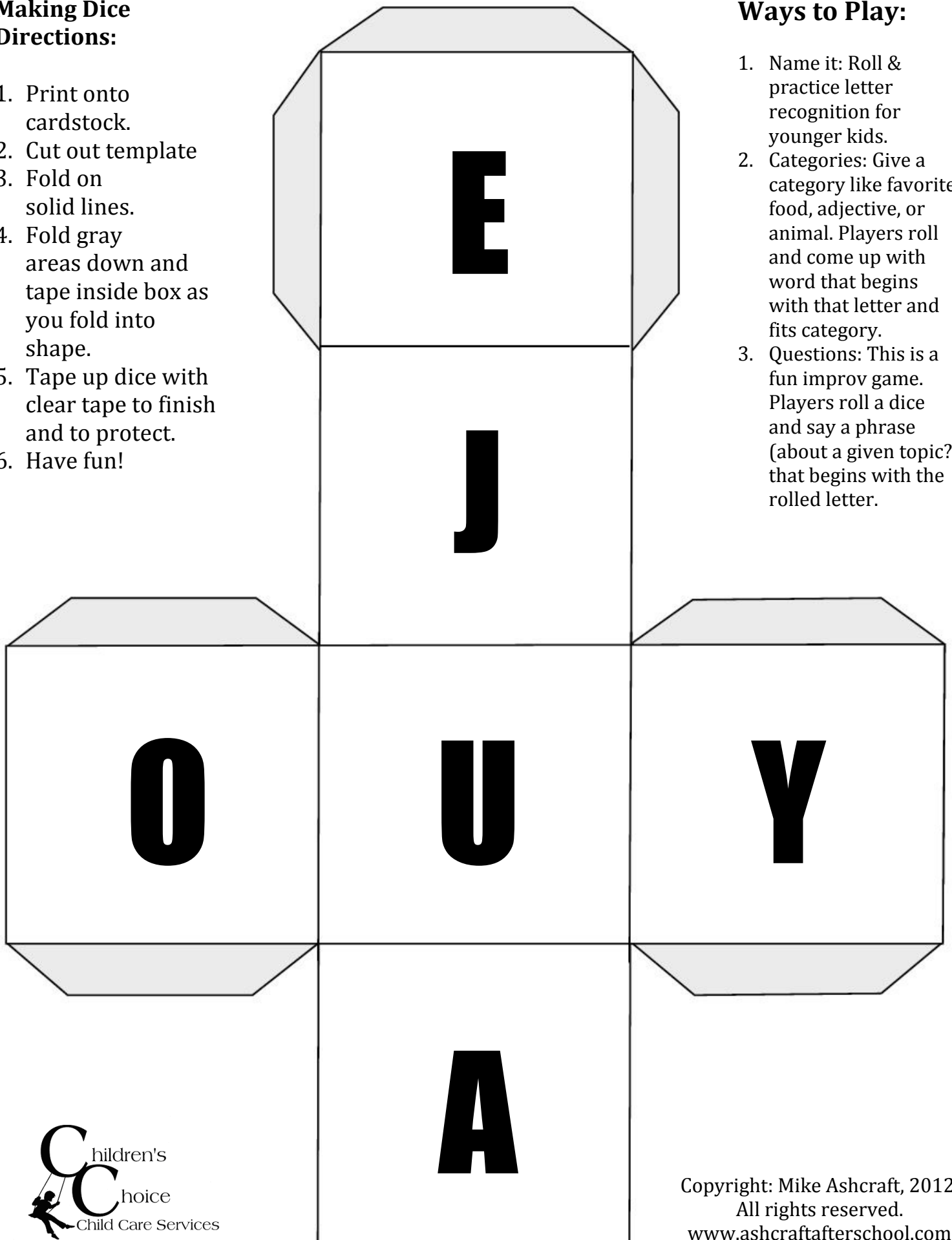
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
